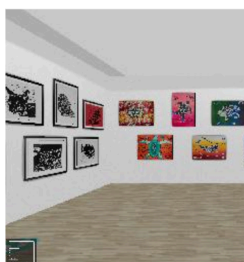


Inclusive Arts Exhibition Call Out

Your artwork will need to link to the exhibition's theme of self-advocacy and speaking up.

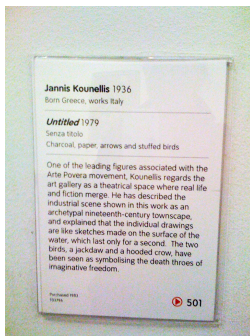


You do not need to make new artwork. You can send in artwork you have already made.

Your description should include:

- ✓ Your name
- ✓ the title of your art
- ✓ what it's made of
- ✓ when you made it
- ✓ what it's about
- ✓ A link to your website if you have one



The description could be written or a video of you talking.
